





## Installation instructions

**Congratulation on your new LINE.**

Please familiarize yourself with this set of installation and care instructions before using the product.





## Installation:


In addition to the included screws and wall anchors, you will also need a power drill, 8mm (5/16") drill bit, and a level.

Locate your desired location for your LINE shelf. Please note that the shelf can either hung to the right or the left.

- 1 Before hanging the shelf, it is essential to affix the four small silicon pads on each corner of the backside of the LINE box.
- 2 Affix the longer silicon pad to the front side of the bend, as shown below. The silicon pads secure a snug and wobble-free fit for the shelf.



- 3 Drill two 8mm (5/16") holes for the two wall anchors at the marked locations. Install the included screws into the wall anchors, careful to leave about 3-4mm (1/8" to 5/32") distance between the wall and the head of the screw.




- 4 Hang the LINE box on the exposed screw-heads, taking care of keeping it level. Finish tightening the screws making sure the LINE box is secured.
- 5 Carefully place the shelf over the LINE box, ensuring it is engaged with the track.

## Optionally:

If you need to place any objects on the shelf that weigh more than 3-5kg (6 1/2 to 11 lbs), it is recommended to use the included support pin. See the image underneath.

The length of the shelf varies depending on the model, and we recommend that you decide whether or not to use the support pin. It is easy to install the support pin afterward.



### NOTE:

The LINE box is not waterproof. If you want to place a plant in the LINE box, we recommend putting a plant saucer underneath.

## Treatment of oak veneered MDF:

The benefit of MDF is that it does not warp or crack over time. Oak veneer can be treated and maintained with wood or teak oils in the same way as solid oak. You can finish your shelf with your unique color and style.

You can also sand the surface with fine-grain sandpaper (min 240 grit) for later maintenance.
